  - Need sign off from GM and ideas on funding sources
  - Bergquist moved to support pursuing the Bumblebee Statue at the corner of MLK and St. Joseph (Camero Corners)
    - Seconded by Nelson, Passed 6-1, Battiste voting no

#### Events

  - Would contract for catering and bartending
    - Could also apply for temporary liquor license through our nonprofit
  - Hecksels volunteered to take charge on the auction again
    - Maybe scaled down version, focusing on return on investment
  - Dates Available: Sunday, November 12 or 19
    - Battiste moved to set the date for Sunday, November 12; Addis seconds; Passes 7-0
    - Nelson moved to approve \$350 to secure the Cadillac Room; DeRushia seconds; Passes 7-0
- O Candidate night
  - Battiste is waiting to hear back from Stevens on location
  - Set for Wednesday, September 27 at 6:00 p.m.
