Rosenberg suggested adding an area to add activities they'd be interested in. Battiste suggested involving non board members in the survey. - O **Inclusion Training** DeRushia met with Antionette and Jill Griffin, independent consultants, to help us figure out how to better engage and create healthy dialogue with neighbors. They presented a plan to

assist with this including board training and plans to help us engage with neighbors. The board wanted to know what they could specifically teach us as a neighborhood association; would it be worth our while; and what do they think about engaging more neighbors in an open dialogue/forum.
