Upcoming Events

- **Family Fun Festival**: This event is slated for Friday, September 8th. There will be lots of family-style fun and activities (i.e., REACH art, games, bounce house, ice cream, etc.) The Lego Batman Movie is the movie of the night.
- Fall Fundraiser: Bergquist talked to Copper Kettle about catering the Fall Festival; they are approved for the Cadillac Room. Potential menu themes include: taco bar; BBQ; family-style Italian; or Thanksgiving dinner with a proposed theme, "We're Thankful For the Westside." Any of the menu options can include vegetarian and gluten free options.
- DeRushia discussed budget of \$2,000.00; Bergquist confirmed.
- The Thanksgiving theme and menu were approved.
- The event will be at the Cadillac Club in REO Town.

 - Consult Danielle on where to get tickets printed.
 - There was further discussion about ticket pricing and whether or not to offer a family rate.
 - **Candidate night:** Elizabeth is coordinating this event. Neighbors with questions should forward them to Elizabeth.
 - **Grants** no report.
 - Crime and Safety (CSC): DeRushia introduced Mitzi Allen, Chair of the Crime and Safety Committee (CSC.) Mitzi read the Mission Statement of the Crime & Safety Committee and reported an overall sense that CSC is lacking support from the WNA. Mitzi reported that 4 neighborhood "block captains" have volunteered, but more are needed. Mitzi reported that the CSC plans to establish a Facebook page that she will moderate. She hopes the FB page will be up by October 1, but does not think that deadline can be met. Mitzi suggested the creation of stickers/signage for homes: "this property is protected by the Westside Neighborhood Watch." Last, Mitzi requested WNA support for the Sexton homecoming parade, which is tentatively scheduled for a date in October. The next CSC meeting is September 26th @ 6:00pm.
